PLACES OF INTEREST Mt Carbine: Founded in 1890 after the discovery of Wolfram deposits. The town has a roadhouse

pub and caravan park. Palmer River: The site of Queensland's largest gold rush in the 1870's. Relics of the gold rush

days can be seen at the roadhouse. Lakeland: A rich fertile farming area where the road divides northwest to Cape York or continues north on the Mulligan Highway to Cooktown. In the small township you can find a hotel/motel

and roadhouse. Black Mountains: A small range surrounded in mystery it is rumoured that many people have

ventured in but never returned. Lions Den Hotel: A historic hotel built in the

1870's on the banks of the Little Annan River. SCENIC STOPS
